The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting to discuss the engineering study on the sanitation plant on August 10, 2004 at 3:30 p.m. in the Commission Room at City Hall.

Mayor White called the meeting to order.

Present: Mayor White and Commissioners Smith and Lentz.

Absent: Commissioners B. Stirton and K. Stirton.

Karen Weathers and Pat Cox from BG Consultants were present along with Donna Crawford from Governmental Assistance Services.

Mr. Cox stated that this was a work session for the engineering report on the sanitation plant. Ms. Weathers reported on the short term and long term options for the plant. It would take approximately 20 acres to build a lagoon for the City of Horton. This would cost approximately \$2 million. Repairs can be made to the existing plant as a temporary repair for \$241,000. For a more permanent repair, a new trickling filter would need to be built. The Commission requested that the engineers come back with a more definite cost for repairing the plant and replacing the trickling filter. Mr. Cox said they would also include a worth analysis.

The KIAC meeting will be held on September 14 and the City would like to be able to attend this meeting and request funding for the project. Donna Crawford will be writing the grant application if it is decided to proceed.

The meeting adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
