Appoint Finance Commissioner to Fill Unexpired Term

A letter of interest was received from Ken Krug for the position of Finance Commissioner. He was not able to be present at the meeting. Mayor White recommended that Mr. Krug be appointed to the position

Motion by Commissioner B. Stirton to appoint Ken Krug as Finance Commissioner to fill the unexpired term of Ron Smith. Seconded by Commissioner K. Stirton. All aye.

Discussion of Removal and Replacement of Tornado Siren

The Electric Department is getting costs on a crane to remove the tornado siren from the roof of the High School. The siren is an older model and will be hard to mount on poles north of the school. It would cost approximately \$9,000 to purchase a new siren. There is the option of a USDA loan. The older one could be used later around Mission Lake after the annexation.

The Commission requested that the City Administrator bring back cost figures for both options.

Mr. Smith reported that the staff would be getting bids to erect the steel building.

A letter was presented written to the township officers explaining the zoning jurisdiction outside the City limits. The Commission requested that something be put in the newspaper to clarify the area to be zoned. The Commission has no intention to zone beyond the area that is being looked at for annexation.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
