The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Friday, December 14, 2007 at 2:40 p.m. in the City Hall Commission Room to discuss contracts for electrical repairs during the ice storm.

Mayor Lentz called the meeting to order.

Mr. Henry reported that there had been no presidential declaration of disaster yet.

The mutual aid electricians will be going home today and there are still over 300 meters down. Dirk Waser and John Harris have been volunteering their time to assist up to this point but need to get back to their businesses. They will assist the City with 2 men crews for \$100 an hour on through Monday, December 17. Rogers and Sons Electric have 2 bucket trucks and 14 men and will come on Tuesday to work until the job is completed. Their charge is \$960 an hour. Mr. Henry will monitor the number of workers on the job during this time.
